Armed Burglary Arrest:

A mobile home was broken into sometime Monday and approximately ten guns were taken. Owner Trinity Sanders, 12/17/77, advised deputies that unknown suspects entered the home apparently through a back window. Once inside, suspects removed high powered rifles, shotguns, and ammunition and fled out of the back door. Witness reports led detectives to believe that juveniles were involved in the burglary. Detective Frank Heinzmann was able to track down one of the juveniles responsible. After obtaining consent to search his residence from a parent, five of the weapons were recovered.

Kyle Davon Johnson, B/M, 11/10/88, of 261 SW Bishop Drive, was arrested for Armed Burglary. Detectives have identified additional suspects in the case and future arrests are anticipated.
