Armed Robbery:

Deputies responded to the California Chicken Grill shortly after midnight regarding an armed robbery. Laura Glover, one of the restaurant's clerks, told Deputy Thomas Kinsey that a lone B/M entered the establishment and produced a handgun. The suspect then demanded money and provided a bag for it to be placed into. He then also demanded money from Glover personally. Several other employees (three) entered the front of the store and the suspect demanded they get on the floor as he fled from the building. No one was injured in the incident.

The suspect is described as a B/M, 20-29 YOA, medium build, last seen wearing a hooded sweatshirt with "Florida" written in orange, black shorts and a camouflage knit cap.
