**Stolen Vehicle/ Homicide Suspect:**

At 12:24 P.M. the Alachua County Sheriff's Office took a report from the owner of a vehicle stolen from the 10000 block of south US 441. The vehicle stolen was a 1989 burgundy Chevy Camaro bearing a possible Michigan tag of YSX 154. The owner stated that the vehicle was taken around mid day while he was fishing alongside US 441. While investigating the theft of the Camaro a stolen 1999 Chrysler Sebring was recovered from the same location. The recovered vehicle belonged to a homicide victim in a double murder that was discovered earlier today in St. Johns County. The Charleston County Sheriff's Department in Georgia is also investigating a homicide. Detectives with all three jurisdictions have reason to believe the murders, theft of both vehicles as well as additional crimes in Alachua County are related.

The statewide BOLO (be on the lookout for) was issued for a 1989 burgundy Chevy Camaro bearing a tag of YSX 154.
