Media Advisory: Funeral Arrangements for Lance Corporal Philip Paul Clark

The Alachua County Sheriff's Office would like to encourage the public to support one of our own fallen heroes on Thursday, May 27, 2010, as the body of Marine Lance Corporal Philip Paul Clark is escorted home to Gainesville. At approximately 1100, the motorcade bearing Lance Corporal Clark will depart Naval Air Station Jacksonville to return to Gainesville on the following route:

- From NAS turn S on SR 17
- Turn right on Kingsley Rd.
- Turn left on SR 21 (Blanding Blvd)
- Veer right on 215
- Turn right on SR 16
- Turn left on US 301
- Veer right on SR 24 in Waldo, FL
- Turn right on NE 39th Avenue
- Turn left on CR 241
- Travel to 823 NW CR 241, William-Thomas Funeral Home in Jonesville

The motorcade is expected to arrive at the funeral home between 2pm and 4pm. The ACSO is requesting as many of Alachua County's citizens as possible to line the roadways along the route in support of the Clark family.
